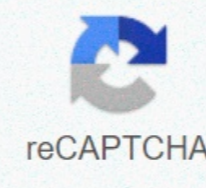

Lovebirds is a gift that insecure and Silicon Valley fans and comedy action lovers will surely love. Had released in cinemas, but luckily Netflix scooped up Lovebirds. The latest version of the streaming platform combines Issa Rae and Kumail Nanjani as a pair on screen (you never knew you needed to date) and adds a fun, deadly twist and deadly soundtrack. Jibrán and Leilani, who have been dating for four years, go to a friend's house for dinner before accidentally hitting a cyclist with their car. The next 24 hours the couple is filled with murders, fights and a very intimidating horse. You will question their hilarious horrible decisions and root their relationship during their crazy journey. The Lovebirds soundtrack has plenty of romantic jams and pump hymns to accompany this normal couple (and audience) on their perilate adventure. The standout song is Katy Perry's Earworm Firework, which is so catchy that it requires singing-a-long from Jibrán and Leilani in the midst of all their chaos. (Seriously, who can resist the belts of this song when it comes?) This soundtrack is just as unexpected as The Lovebirds storyline. While the songs from HBO's Max's An American Pickle may not end up on the next workout playlist, they should definitely be added to the mix for the next barbat mitzvah attend. With very few actual hit tracks in the new film, starring Seth Rogen in two roles, the result remains to give emotional weight to each scene, and they all sound like something bubbah or zayde will dance. The music was composed by Oscar winner Michael Giacchino, best known for his work with Pixar (the theme of Up that makes you cry? It's his), Marvel and Star Trek films and Israeli composer Nami Melumad. It is certainly considered contemporary in terms of how it makes the film feel, but at the same time it feels like it has come straight out of the so-called old country. And if you know anything about how Giacchino titles his songs, they are always punny and sometimes so on the nose hurts. He was up to his usual antics with American Pickle because his song itself naming tradition continued, but this time with a jiddish twist. Yiddish is used a lot in film as Rogen launches in full monologues in the language. While his dialogue is not subtitled for us to understand, the titles of Jezdy Giacchino and Melumad are at least a little more common. When Rogen's Herschel and Ben Greenbaum get into a brawl with a group of cossacks, the music played on stage sounds like Klezmer Fight Club. Later, when Herschel has to go and find Ben, that song is appropriately titled Schleppling to Schlupsk – when was the last time he schlepped somewhere? The soundtrack also has a few cucumber puns, because of course it does. One appropriately named track is Pickle Your Fancy, and hopefully you understand that you play on words. The final song of the film is The Silver Brining, which certainly sounds silver lining, but is actually curing the term, which means soaking something in salt water. And let's not forget the end of the subtitles of the song Pickles, Suite or Sour, given that cucumbers can be sweet or sour, and also the package is a common musical melody. They are so clever that it hurts. If yiddish and cucumbers are not a thing, there are also two perfectly placed Star Wars jokes on the soundtrack. Giacchino composed music for Rogue One: A Star Wars Story, but here the tribute consists of the original back-to-back trilogy of songs, Regene of the Ben and The Pickle Empire Strikes Back. Checking out the American pickle soundtrack may not be the first thing you do after the movie ends, but like Herschel, take a few seconds to appreciate the beauty and wonder of the world, as well as cucumber puns. Who runs the world? How about a 50 Ft Woman beyoncé style attack? The singer/female active wear designer/dominator of the world is just one of many music artists to have their songs turned into grindhouse movie posters. MusiXploitation is a series of posters for movies that exist only in the hearts of angry fans. In the late 1990s, Master P would release feature films with the same titles as his albums, which were sort of fictional precursors to Lemonade with some seriously fraught dialogues. This new series is a glimpse into a world where this practice has been caught all over the music industry. Created by Paris-based artistic director David Redon, the series includes blaxploitation-style posters for songs and albums by Amy Winehouse, 2Pac and Jay-Z. (Previously, Redon had mashed up musicians with vintage commercials.) Some are thematically appropriate, like the galactic Frank Ocean, the ghostly Pyramids, and others no doubt their namesakes as upset as Lauryn Hill's Miseducation transformed into a bikini bank robbery caper. Like the recent covers of Quentin Tarantino's books on Co.Create, some entries are plagued by almost comically poor Photoshop.
